We had such an amazing turnout for CCP donors, we had the third largest inventory of that plasma product in the country! We were not only able to meet the needs of our local hospitals, but we were able to help other hospitals across the nation as well. Even as the FDA increased their restrictions for collecting the product, we were always able to maintain a steady supply. Now that the demand is finally decreasing, as well as the FDA guidelines limiting our collection options for CCP with the vaccine roll out, we have officially put a pause on this collection type. THIS IS A GOOD THING!

As our city/state/country becomes more and more vaccinated, we can finally begin to look, and plan, for a return to "normal." In our world, that would mean a return to gatherings, in-person meetings and our events. So hopefully by the time I send this newsletter out for the next quarter, we'll have a plan to resume regular meetings and plan for that annual Volunteer Event!
