The major hiccup occurred when it was introduced to the House of Representatives. The only way it was going to proceed to be voted on in the House was if it was amended to limit tax exemptions to only items used in the collection, processing, and testing of our communities' blood supply. This was a huge step forward, but we are still one of three states who require non-profit blood centers to pay taxes on other items, like software and computer services. So next year, we'll continue on with our discussions with our state lawmakers.

So thank you everyone who was able to come out and make it the fun time it was. Also, my trips to the Mason City and Cedar Valley areas were great as well! 
